

Welcome to the 2023 Bemidji Curling Rocks Junior Bonspiel!

U14 Division plays 6 ends. U21 Division plays 8 ends. There is a buzzer that will sound after 2 hours in which the game should finish after the conclusion of whatever end the game is currently in during the buzzer.

Games will be using the 5 guard rule but will not be following the no tick rule. If a match is tied after a full game, skip's rocks will determine winner. A full extra end will determine winners in the championship rounds. If there is a need for measurement or rules question give the X symbol and an event official will come to help.

First end hammer for each match will be determined by a coin flip. Colored coins are above the drink holders.

Teams must hang their scores during the match, including the last end, and leave them up. Event officials will take down scores before the next match.

Each team is allowed 1 coaching time out per match. These are intended to be a teaching moment so teams should be mindful of time. No coaching behind the glass! Coaches may call timeouts. Both coaches may go out, but to the home end only and not on the ice!

There will be Breakfast available on Saturday and Sunday morning. Lunch on Saturday and Sunday and dinner on Saturday only. Meals are free for players and young children. It is a suggested donation for adults.

Each player will receive 10 tickets for a chance to win their choice from our fantastic selection of raffle prizes! Write your name on each ticket. Additional raffle tickets can be purchased at 1/\$1, 15/\$10 or double arms' length/\$20. Raffle prizes will be drawn Saturday evening after 9:15 pm and tickets will be set on prizes for Sunday pick-up. We are not able to mail prizes to winners. Some larger prizes cannot be won by the same person. Raffle items will be displayed upstairs in the club.

Team pictures will be taken upstairs at the kitchen level before or after the game and posted on our website.

Trophies are given to teams in the championship games of each division. First place teams from each division will have their names engraved on the Curling Rocks Junior Bonspiel trophy!

The bar is open during the event. Beer and seltzers are available for purchase. Pop is free to all players and children. Tap root beer and Shirley temples are available for \$ 1. Bringing alcohol into the facility is not allowed.

Lakeside Curling will be selling curling equipment from noon Saturday until noon Sunday.
